Sub:Implementation of automated clearance on All India basis

Attention of the Importers. Exporters. Customs Brokers, and all other stakeholders, is invited to the CBIC Circular No.05/2020-Customs dated 27.01.2020 vide which facility of automated clearance was implemented on a pilot basis at two customs locations- Chennai Custom House and Jawaharlal Nehru Custom House w.e.f. 06.02.2020.

2. The Board has reviewed the implementation of the pilot roll-out of automated clearance at the two aforesaid Customs locations and has now decided to extend the facility of automated clearance of Bills of Entry to all Customs formations where the Customs EDI system is operational, w.e.f. 05.03.2020.

3. The important features of the automated clearance are as follows:

- i) The facility will only be for ICES locations where RMS is enabled and fully functional.
- ii) All the Customs Compliance Verification (CCV) requirements under the Customs Act, rules, instructions etc will be done by the designated proper officer of Customs.
- iii) The CCV would operate even while duty has not been paid or payment is under process.
- iv) After completion of CCV, the proper officer of Customs, on satisfaction that the goods are ready for clearance, will confirm the completion of the CCV for the particular Bill of Entry in the Customs System
- v) On confirmation of payment of applicable duty, the Customs System will then electronically give clearance to the Bill of Entry.

4. As detailed above, after the goods registration is complete, the designated proper officer of Customs would do all the necessary verifications of Customs Compliance Verification (CCV) requirements under the Customs Act, rules, instructions etc. and will give OOC the same

way in the System as is being given now from the SUP Role. The other conditions, except the condition of duty payment would still be checked by System at the time of goods registration. Once the OOC is given, the BE will not move to GAT queue automatically. Instead, it would move to CCV queue which can be checked from the BE movement. Once the payment is made by the importer and in integrated in the System, the BE would instantly move to GAT queue and OOC print would be available for generation. If the Importer has already paid the applicable duties by the time the proper officer has processed it for CCV, the BE would immediately go to the GAT queue after the OOC is given by the officer in System. Similarly, the deferred duty BEs shall also move to GAT immediately without waiting for duty payment.

5. The contents of this public notice shall operate as a Standing Order so far as officers and staff of Custom House Marmagoa are concerned.
