### STANDING ORDER - 02/2021

### Subject: Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment Regulations (SCMTR) 2018

Attention of all officers is invited to CBIC circular 12/2021-Customs dated 30-6-2021 on the above subject( copy enclosed) regarding implementation of the above regulations.

- 2. In this context, Board has pointed out that the arrival and departure or associated activity mandated manifest filings are interlinked with vessel movement (that is, a ship-call at port) which covers inbound and outbound cargo including transhipment. Deviations from mandated electronic filings are permissible only with the approval of Commissioner or his authorised officer. From this it is evident that mandated electronic declarations/filings can be monitored based on ship-call activity and that jurisdictional officers have ownership over the filings. The designated ADG (ICES/ICEGATE) in the Directorate of Systems and Data Management is always available to resolve any genuine difficulty referred but it would be inappropriate to refer improper filing attempt that arise from inadequate and distanced supervision by jurisdictional officers.
- 3. Board has also pointed out that for ensuring successful/error-free/timely completion of every individual filing by respective entities for a particular ship-call, each AC/DC level officer in the Zone is an available resource for making specifically responsible for that ship-call. In a sense, the specific AC allocated for particular ship-call can act as a benefactor enabling desired outcome while his reporting/reviewing JC/Commr shares this responsibility. Every AC/DC in the Zone can be given this task for separate ship-calls so that there are sufficient benefactors. This is an eminently plannable activity as all ship calls are ascertainable in advance.
- 4. Board has also enclosed the following formats of a monitoring log for successful error free filing of mandated messages for each ship call, which are indicated as **Annexure A**, **B1** and **B2** respectively
